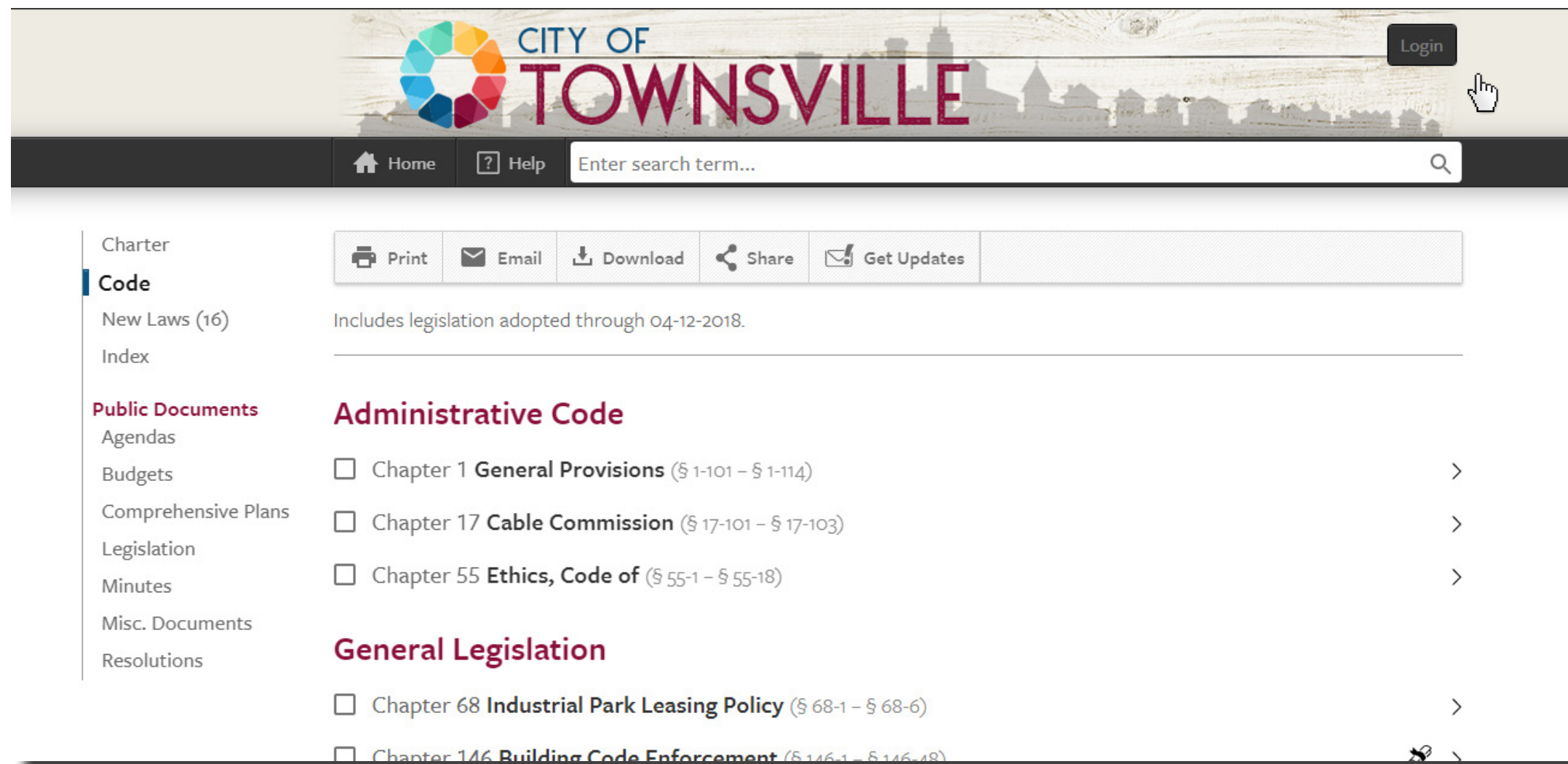





§ 1-101. Penalties for offenses.

[Amended 7-2-2002 by L.L. No. 3-2002; 3-1-2006 by Ord. No. 2006-5; 3-6-2013 by L.L. No. 1-2013]

1. Unless a different penalty is specified, violations of the provisions of this Code shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$250 or imprisonment for a term of not more than 15 days, and not less than \$100 or 25 hours of community service.
